



COVID-19 PLAN INFORMATION

We care about the health & safety of the families who play at Good Times Park®. Cleanliness of the Park continues to be extremely important to us. We will do our part to provide a clean play space (which includes daily 'clean-while-working' by our team & a full nightly cleaning/sanitizing by professional cleaners, as always), to follow the mandated operational restrictions & to reasonably enforce mask compliance as required by the State of Minnesota's Executive Orders.

However, you will be expected to do your part to:

- Not visit the Park if any member of your family is sick, has symptoms or has had symptoms of a contagious illness (including a cough, fever, rash, vomiting, shortness of breath, etc.) within the last 48 hours, or has been exposed to or is in quarantine due to exposure or contact with someone who is sick;
- (Per the State of Minnesota's Executive Orders) Ensure that each person age 6 years & older for whom you are responsible appropriately wears a proper face covering AT ALL TIMES while inside the Park. Children age 3-5 years are encouraged to wear a face covering, but are not required. The face covering may only be temporarily removed while socially distanced AND seated in the picnic area AND actively eating. Persons with medical conditions approved in the mandate may be exempt from wearing a face covering;
- Wash hands regularly but at least before/after eating in the Park; and
- Consume any food, snack or beverage while seated in the picnic area only. When done eating, clear your garbage, use the table wipes & brooms provided to clean your area (& clean/put away the highchair), and store your personal items in the cubbies. As usual, please avoid 'snack buffets' which encourage children to play/snack/play.

Since Good Times Park offers an unstructured, self-use play space for families to enjoy together, minimal staff is necessary to supervise play activities. However, activities in the Park are diligently monitored. Park staff are kept busy providing respectful & courteous customer service, maintaining the cleanliness & security of the Park & consistently enforcing the Park's rules to ensure a safe, secure & fun play space for all families to enjoy.

We expect that all families entering Good Times Park understand the Park's rules & the importance of following these expectations, especially during this time. If Park staff are subject to negative or derogatory comments, confrontation, or refusal to follow the Park's rules or the State of Minnesota's required mandates, the offending customer(s) will be required to immediately leave the Park without refund.
